Public Comment Period Closes July 2

View public hearing documents and submit comments on 52@65 project

Members of the public are encouraged to submit their comments and feedback on the proposed 52@65 project near Lebanon, Indiana. The public comment period will end on July 2.

The Indiana Department of Transportation's (INDOT) planned 52@65 project near Lebanon, Indiana, will provide enhanced mobility and direct access at the I-65 and U.S. 52 interchange. All public comments will be compiled and taken into consideration for the final design.

"Like all of our projects, INDOT is committed to a design process that features robust communication and collaboration with stakeholders," said INDOT West Central Spokesperson Blake Dollier. "We encourage residents, businesses, and organizations to submit their public comment."

The project is still in the design phase, and the final design is expected to be complete in late 2024. In addition to providing immediate benefits to the community, this project will allow the region to handle future connectivity and access requirements.
